

Taxes are the means used by the government to raise money for its expenditures. Taxes have never been popular. Tax assessments are typically based on the benefits realized and on an individual's ability to pay. Two of the most common taxes are the personal income tax and the sales tax.

The personal income tax is the assessment individuals are required to pay on their earnings. Employers deduct this tax from employees' paychecks. The sales tax is another assessment with which the majority of people are familiar. It is a tax that is added to the retail price of a good or service. While the income tax is an assessment based on an individual's ability to pay, the general sales tax is based on the benefits a person receives.
